A Cement Bond-Variable Density Log was recorded in your South Hobbs Unit #26 well in Lea County on March 25, 1978. The log was recorded inside a 4½" liner from 4180' - 3841'.

The following interpretation was made from this log:

<u>INTERVAL</u>	<u>INTERPRETATION</u>	<u>REASON</u>
4180' - 4008'	Excellent Bond	Transit Time Curve indicated strong formation arrivals - VDL also displayed strong formation arrivals.
4008' - 3970'	Poor Bond	High amplitude readings on Amplitude Curve and strong casing arrivals on VDL.
3970' - 3841'	Excellent Bond	Formation arrivals predominate on the Transit Time Curve and VDL.
