Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 1655' in anhydrite. Ran 52.4 jts. (1642.28') of 8 5/8" OD 24 & 32# casing set at 1652' and cemented with 536 sacks Trinity Inferno w/1/4 cu.ft. strata crete/sack and 6% gel followed w/200 sacks neat. Plug was down at 6:20 AM, February 7, 1959. Cement circulated. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before testing for shut-off. Prior to and after drilling plug, 1000 pounds pressure was applied during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure.
