FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The 5-1/2" casing was set at 7114' and cemented with 200 sacks sulphate resisting cement. On April 24, 1950, at 5:00 A.M., 48 hours will have elapsed since cementing the casing. At that time, pipe and water shut-off will be tested with 1,000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement in the shoe to 7106'.

In the event a satisfactory shut-off is not obtained, adequate remedial measures will be taken. If tests are satisfactory, completion operations will be commenced.
