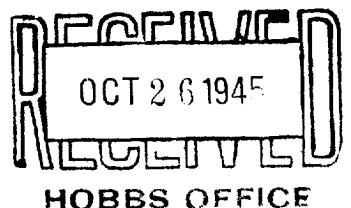

The dates of this work were as follows: Plugging operations commenced 10/15/45 - Completed 10/23/45

Notice of intention to do the work was ~~submitted~~ submitted on Form C-102 on October 15, 1945and approval of the proposed plan was ~~obtained~~ obtained. (Cross out incorrect words.)

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The subject well has been abandoned and plugged according to following procedure: - 1090' of 5 1/2" casing was recovered; a 30-sx. cement plug was set at 7689; a 20-sx. plug was set in top of 5 1/2" at 1090; 8-5/8" casing was parted at 691 and pulled; a 10-sx. cement plug was placed in top of the 8-5/8" remaining in hole, which was set thru the salt section at 3184 w/400 sacks. All intervals between plugs were filled with mud laden fluid. The 13-3/8" surface casing set at 266' with 150 sacks was left intact. The top 15' of this string was filled with cement and a 4" pipe marker set in the cement to extend 5' above ground level.
