This well was spudded March 14, 1956. A 12-1/4" hole was drilled to 350'.
8-5/8" 24# J-55 casing was cemented at 343' using 325 sacks of cement
(90-90 Poccin-Incor) w/2% Gell. Cement was allowed to set 36 hours before
resuming operations. The casing and cement job was tested to 600 psi and
found to be O. K.
