

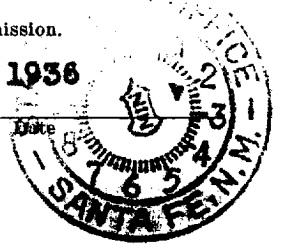

REGULATIONS ON THE PERMIT TO HOLD A BUSINESS



1980

Section 1. Title and Purpose. These regulations shall govern the issuance, renewal, and cancellation of permits to hold a business in the Philippines.

Section 2. Definitions. For the purposes of these regulations, the following terms shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

Section 3. Issuance of Permits. A permit to hold a business shall be issued to any person who is a citizen of the Philippines and who is qualified to engage in the business.

Section 4. Renewal of Permits. A permit to hold a business shall be renewed annually, unless otherwise provided for in the permit.

Section 5. Cancellation of Permits. A permit to hold a business shall be cancelled if the holder thereof is found to be engaged in an illegal business or if he is found to be in violation of the conditions of the permit.

Section 6. Penalties. Any person who is found to be in violation of these regulations shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the law.

Section 7. Enforcement. These regulations shall be enforced by the Bureau of Trade and Industry.

DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

1. The permit to hold a business shall be issued to any person who is a citizen of the Philippines and who is qualified to engage in the business.

2. A permit to hold a business shall be renewed annually, unless otherwise provided for in the permit.

3. A permit to hold a business shall be cancelled if the holder thereof is found to be engaged in an illegal business or if he is found to be in violation of the conditions of the permit.

4. Any person who is found to be in violation of these regulations shall be liable to the penalties provided for in the law.

5. These regulations shall be enforced by the Bureau of Trade and Industry.
