DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Loaded hole with 69 bbls. oil. Acidized through tubing with 1,000 gallons 15% regular acid by Chemical Process. TP - 600-1850#, CP 900-1950#. Average injection rate 40 GPM. Injectime time 25 minutes. Duration time 30 minutes. Completed at 11:40 A.M., June 14, 1951.

RESULTS--Flowed 15 barrels of 30.2 gravity oil and 14 barrels water through 2 3/8" tubing open in 24 hours ending 3:00 P.M. June 21, 1951. 24 hours gas volume 404.600 cf. GOR 26,973 estimated potential 15 barrels. Penalized allowable 6 barrels per day.
