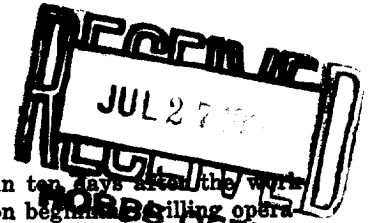

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized with 1,000 gallons of 15% acid, used 100 gallons jelly seal for bottom hole plug. In 24 hours well produced 40 barrels of oil and 135 barrels of water, Gas-Oil ratio 1450 to 1. Acidized by Dowell, Inc.
