Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EMIT WATER POLLUTANTS

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the State Geologist, under the authority of the Department of the State, has received an application from the applicant for a permit to discharge pollutants into the waters of the State. The applicant is the owner of the facility and is responsible for the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility. The applicant is required to submit a permit application to the Department of the State Geologist, which includes a detailed description of the facility, the nature and quantity of the pollutants to be discharged, and the methods to be used to control the discharge of pollutants. The Department of the State Geologist will review the permit application and, if necessary, will require the applicant to provide additional information. The Department of the State Geologist will issue a permit to discharge pollutants if the applicant meets the requirements of the Department of the State Geologist. The permit will specify the conditions under which the applicant may discharge pollutants into the waters of the State. The applicant is required to comply with the conditions of the permit and to submit reports to the Department of the State Geologist as required. The Department of the State Geologist will enforce the conditions of the permit and may take action against the applicant if the applicant fails to comply with the conditions of the permit.
