Figure 1. The proposed model for the development of the self-regulated learning strategy. The model illustrates the relationship between various factors influencing the development of self-regulated learning strategies. The factors are categorized into three main groups: Personal Factors, Environmental Factors, and Instructional Factors. Personal Factors include Self-efficacy, Self-regulation, and Self-monitoring. Environmental Factors include Social Support, Cultural Context, and Learning Environment. Instructional Factors include Teacher's Role, Instructional Materials, and Instructional Strategies. The model shows how these factors interact to influence the development of self-regulated learning strategies, which are then used to enhance learning outcomes.
