1. Kill well w/ Aquagel mud, 40 Vis. w/ 5# Krevis stop per bbl.
2. Pull tubing & Packer
3. Clean out
4. Run caliper survey
5. Run tubing w/ Guiberson Packer to set at point to be determined from caliper log, as high as possible below 3800'.
6. Test packer
7. Swab in and test

Will consider acidizing after testing as above.
