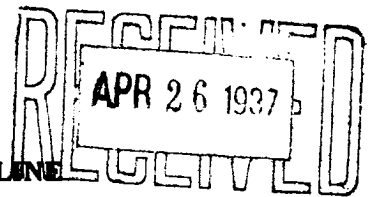

Additional information:

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3905'. 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3895'. Well swabbed 24 hours. Then flowed 7 barrels oil per hour on 1 hour test. Through 32/64" Choke and died.

Acidized w/ 2000 gallons of Dowell XX Acid. Acid was flushed with 32 barrels oil. The acid was allowed to stand for 6 hours. The well was swabbed in and flowed 271 barrels oil on 8 hour test. Hourly average of 33.9 barrels. Flowing through 1" open choke on 2 1/2" tubing. Daily gas rate of 547,000. Gas oil ratio 670. Casing pressure 260#. Tubing pressure 50#.
