DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 24, 1954, dumped 12 gals Hydromite on top of fishat 3889', no fill up. Dumped 12 gals hydromite and filled up from 3889-3882'. Dumped 4 gals hydromite and hole filled to 3880'. Dumped 6 gals hydromite at 3880', no fill up. Dumped 8 gals hydromite and hole filled from 3880-3874'. Dumped 12 gals hydromite and hole filled from 3874-3869'. Dumped 6 gals hydromite and hole filled from 3869-3867'. Dumped 4 gals hydromite and there was no fill up. Dumped 8 gals hydromite and hole filled up to 3864'. Dumped 4 gals hydromite, no fill up. Dumped 8 gals hydromite and hole filled to 3860'. Ran tubing and started swabbing. Well kicked off and started flowing.

Flowed on Oil Conservation Commission Test 59 bbls oil and 60 bbls water in 24 hours. Allowable before plugging back 0 bopd. Allowable after plugging back 40 bopd.
