DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 5-1/2" Baker 17# Model "N" Magnesium bridging plug at 3860' by Lane Wells. Dumped 1-1/2 sacks common cement on top. Loaded hole with water. Tested casing with 800# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Ran steel line and found top of cement at 3852'. Perforated 5-1/2" casing with 4 jet holes per foot from 3800-3840'. Total 160 holes by Lane Wells. Job complete at 10:00 a.m. 12-12-51.

RESULTS:

Production before: 14 oil, 350 water per day on outside gas.

Production after: December 13, 1951, flowed 42 oil, 63 water with outside gas.
