NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Well No. 24 in of Sec. 10, T. 2, R. 22, N. M. P. M., Oil Field, County, on Dec. 17, 1939. 36 lb. casing was { ~~landed~~ cemented } in formation at a depth of 4075 feet on Dec. 17, 1939. 100 sacks of Inscr cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: circulation - per its 2-plug system

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
