McCormack Well No. 1, in Sec. 32, T. 21 S., R. 37 E., and your Eunice King Well No. 1, in Sec. 28, T. 21 S., R. 37 E., which I rejected because forms C-101's "Notice of Intention to Drill" for these wells specify that the intermediate string of casing is to be set on top of the salt. You undoubtedly know, that the "long String" program must be followed in order to save bradenhead gas.
