

accordance with calculation tables. No gas was encountered in the Brown Lime, which was largely anhydrite. In fact, we encountered anhydrite in this well as deep as 3350 feet. The top of the Ramsay was encountered at 3535 feet, so that no gas producing formation is open above the cement.

I regret that this error cropped into our operations, yet since no damage should result from the present construction of the well, I do not feel that the company should be required to repair the well. Please advise your reaction unofficially, and I will see that the thing is carried through in the proper manner later.
