**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Pulled 2½" tubing and re-ran same with 5½" OD x 2½" x 40" rubber Robinson anchor packer set at 3998-4000 and 5' perforations from 3959-64. Acidized above packer with 1000 gallons Chemical Process Acid. Average injection pressure on tubing 890#, on casing 1030#.

Swabbed well in and on 24-hour test well flowed 67 barrels of oil plus 8 barrels of water through 14/64" choke. GOR 4,450.
