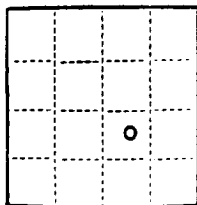

Plan to drill a Devonian test well to a depth of approximately 14,750'. The casing program is as follows:

13-3/8", 48# set at 850' with 725 sacks cement, circulated.

9-5/8" , 36# & 40#, set at 5,500' with 3,000 sacks cement, circulated.

7", 26# & 29#, set at 14,500' with 1,250 sacks cement, sufficient to protect all known oil and water formations.

All casing will be cemented and tested by approved methods.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

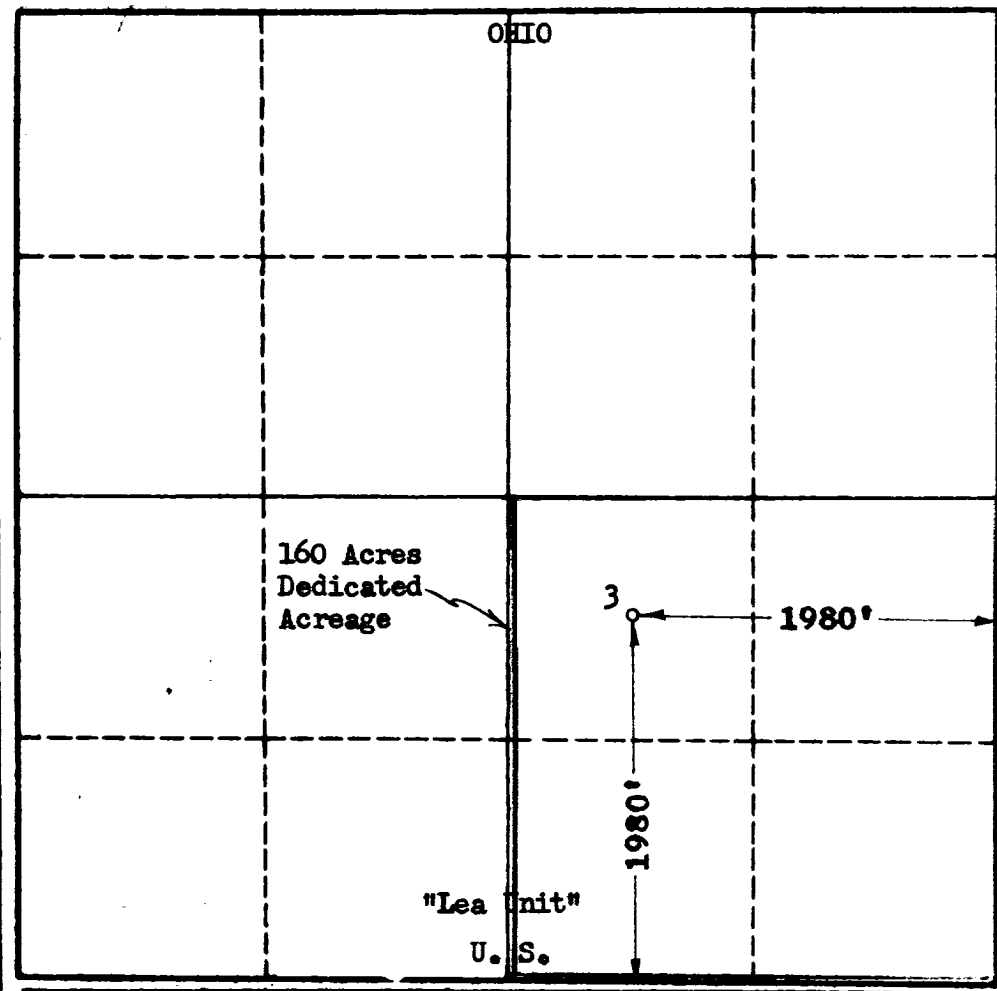
