The following information is submitted in support of our application to drill the above captioned well.

- 1. Existing Roads:
 - A. State Hwy 322, this highway is 660' south of location going west and east. Monument, New Mexico is approximately one-half mile west from entrance to proposed location. (See Attachment No. 1 shown in red).
 - B. State Hwy 8, this highway goes north and south at Monument, New Mexico and intersects Hwy 322. Hwy 8 is approximately one-half mile west from entrance of location. (See Attachment No. 1 shown in red).
 - C. Old road with ruts in Section 28, which is 120' east of location that goes south 660' to State Hwy 322. (See Attachment No. 1 shown in blue).
- 2. Planned Access Road:
 - A. Will re-construct old road with ruts which is 120' east of location that goes south 660' to State Hwy 322. Old road has been marked with flags (see Attachment No. 1 shown in blue).
 - B. Road will be re-constructed with caliche 6" thick, 12' wide and 550' long, watered and compacted.
 - C. Barb-wire fence with steel gate is running west and east by Hwy 322. Will use present gate as entrance.
- 3. Location of Existing Wells: See Attachment No. 2,
- 4. Location of Tank Battery and Flowline: Tank battery will be built on well pad. Production facilities will be fenced. See Attachment No. 3.
- 5. Location and Type Water Supply: Fresh water will be obtained three miles from location and brine water at Hobbs, New Mexico 11 miles. Water will be hauled by transports.
