

Proposed Development Plan for Surface Use

Federal AG Com. #1
1980' FNL & 1980' FWL, Sec. 14, T-20-S R-35-E

1. Existing roads including location of exit from main highway.

Detailed map showing drillsite location in relation to the nearest town and all existing roads within one mile of the wellsite are shown on Exhibit A. From Eunice go 6.4 miles west on Highway 8. Turn off on Highway 176 and go west 9 miles, Turn north on County Road 35. Get off pavement at Wilson camp and continue North. The access road begins 8.4 miles from leaving highway 176.

2. Planned access roads.

Approx. 4000 ft. of access road will be built.

3. Location of existing wells.

All existing well within one mile radius are shown on Exhibit C.

4. Location of tank batteries and flow lines

If the well is commercially productive, the production facilities (i.e. tanks, separators, & treaters) will be located on existing pad.

5. Location and type of water supply.

Fresh & brine water to be hauled by commercial hauler.

6. Source of construction materials.

Caliche will be obtained from a pit in Unit K of Sec. 24, T-20-S R-35-S

7. WASTE DISPOSAL

- a. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the reserve pit.
- b. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the reserve pit until the pit is dry.
