Per your application dated June 10, 1991, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas Pool production to the previously approved non-standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 of Section 36, Township 20S, Range 36E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (Division Administrative Order NSP-41, dated December 20, 1954), from the existing

Shell State Well No. 10 located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 36 and to the proposed

Shell State Well No. 9 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 36.
