13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting and proposed work. January 27, 1993-8:00 AM: Began reverse drilling with tubing conveyed 4-3/4 drill bit. Drilling began at 3685 feet and ceased at 3703 feet, having drilled a total of 18 feet. We penetrated the top of the Seven Rivers Reef at; 3698 feet, at approximately 1:00 PM. Samples which were circulated to the surface confirmed this fact.

At reaching TD we continued to circulate until no further cuttings surfaced. Pulled tubing, drill collars and bit and ran tubing back into hole, tagged bottom to confirm TD of 3703 feet. Pulled one joint to pipe and ran pump and rods back into hole. Began pumping at 6:00 PM. Experience stuck pump but was able to correct over about a 36 hour period. Testing: pumped approximately 120 bbls /day.

Feb. 1, 1993- Produced 329 bbls of water over the last 72 hours, about 2% oil and 98% water. Evaluating at this point what action to take. If oil to water ratio continues we will have to investigate ways of shutting off water and producing from the same Yates "C" zone as before.

If this doesn't prove productive we will come back up the casing to approximately 3650 feet and set a bridge plug accompanied with 12 to 20 sacks of cement. Will plan on perforating the upper Yates Zones which occur between 3518 and 3558.
