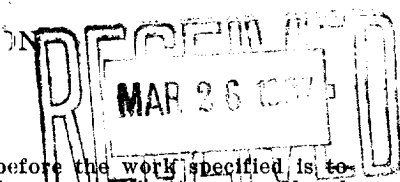

Resolved, That the City of Dallas, Texas, do hereby authorize the City Engineer to execute and deliver to the City of Dallas, Texas, a certificate of incorporation for the City of Dallas, Texas, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of the Legislature of the State of Texas, passed on the 10th day of May, 1900, and to cause the same to be recorded in the public records of the County of Dallas, Texas.
