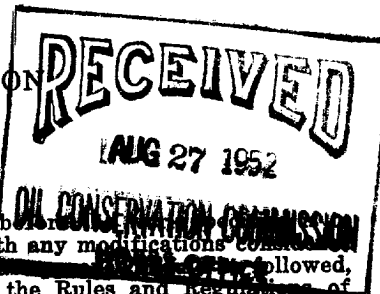

This well was drilled to a total depth of 9165'. Ran 272-1/3 jts (9153') of 5 1/2" OD 8rd thd. csg. and set at 9165'. Cemented with 468 sacks containing 4% gel and 55 sacks of Strata Crete. Followed w/150 sacks neat. FP 1000#. Plug down at 9:08 PM, 8-24-52. Cement will be allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off.
