Gentlemen:

An exception is requested to Order No. 1417, Rule 3 (b) of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission for E. P. Campbell No. 1 Schermerhorn located in Unit P, Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, in the Jalmat Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

As indicated by the accompanying plat, Phillips Petroleum Company has a low pressure gas line which is located approximately 300 feet from the tank battery of this lease. Phillips Petroleum Company's Engineers have tested this well in December 1959 and have reported that there is insufficient gas being produced from the lease to warrant connection. Phillips Petroleum Company further stated that they intend to periodically test this well for gas quantity and will provide a connection as soon as it is justified.
