13" 40# ST Casing set in Red Bed Formation at 208'7" and cemented with 250 sacks of cement. Total depth of hole 220'. Casing was tested by bailing the hole dry and allowing same to set for 1 hour. Casing tested OK. This test was made after cement had been allowed to set for 36 hours.
