DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

March 23, 1943. Removed packer and installed Bryon Surface control equipment, (Bryon wire line operated drop valve w/ 12/64" choke center section at 3861', 10' x 61/2 weight bar and 3861' of .092 wire line. Surface equipment: 2" x 10' lubricator, pulley, 5' piston and counterbalance weights, 24 hour Haulen-Waters time cycle w/ 3 hour cycle disc.

Production before:- Well had a GOR of 18,516.

Production after:- Flowed 36 bbls oil and no water in 24 hours on State Test (Last 24 hrs) Flowing, 1 1/2 hours open and 1 1/2 hours closed gas 248,000 cu. ft. GOR 8,888.
