## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 17, 1951, at 5:40 pm. 48 hours had elapsed after running 6736' of new 5½" casing landed at 6748', and cemented with 180 sacks 4% jel and 45 sacks signalite. Top of cement was indicated to be 4570 by temperaturesurvey. Casing was tested with 1000 psi before and after plug was drilled for 30 minutes. Since there was no drop in pressure, test was considered satisfactory. Completion operations were resumed.
