Gentlemen:

Enclosed please find applications to dual complete our Livingston Nos. 8 and 10 in the Blinebry oil and Drinkard pools. As illustrated on the attached plat, Livingston 8 is located in Unit N, Section 3, and Livingston 10 is located in Unit P, Section 4, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The two wells will flow both zones through separate strings of tubing, and a permanent packer will isolate the two intervals. This method is similar to that employed in our Livingston No. 5, which is dually completed in the Blinebry oil and Drinkard pools in Unit U, Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Because Livingston No. 8 is now dualled in the Blinebry gas and Drinkard pools, a second packer will be used to shut off the gas production. When Livingston No. 8 is completed successfully in the Blinebry Oil Pool, a request will be submitted to cancel the dual completion order that now permits the production of Blinebry gas and Drinkard oil.

All operators listed in Item 5 of the applications have been notified by copies of this letter. Please advise if further information is desired concerning this application.
