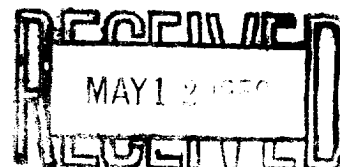

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well has been on temporary abandoned status since May 11, 1949, on which date the well became unprofitable to operate.

Deeper production has been condemned by virtue of deepening the J. P. Alexander "B" No. 2.

The following casing strings are in the hole at the present time:

13" casing 70# @ 146' cemented with 100 sacks in 17" hole.
9-5/8" casing 36# @ 1341' cemented with 500 sacks in 12" hole.
7" casing 22# @ 3516' cemented with 300 sacks in 8-3/4" hole.

An attempt will be made to recover the uncemented portion of the 9-5/8" and 7" casing strings, and cement plugs placed as follows in order to isolate the salt section and all fluid bearing zones: (over)

20 sacks cement plug in 7" csg. stub	1450-1550'
20 sacks cement plug	At Surface

A heavily mud laden fluid will be mixed and placed between all cement plugs. The location will be cleared and a 4" marker will be erected to extend 4 feet above the ground level, in compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
