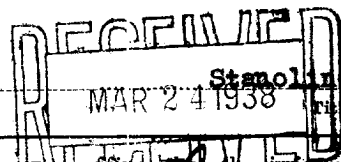
## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 PM March 21, 1938, 72 hours had elapsed, at which time we tested 9-5/8" CD new casing set at 1336' and cemented with 500 sax.

We conducted the test in the following manner: Built up 1000# pressure, closed valves and held for 30 minutes. Tested okay, drilled plug, built up 1000# pressure, closed valves and held for 30 minutes.
