DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to a depth of 7463 and 5 1/8". 15.50 Lbs. csg. was cemented at 7462 with 500 sacks of cement (400 sks w/4% gel, 100 sks. neat). The plug was pumped down at 6:15 am 1-12-50. A temperature survey indicated the top of cement at 4540'. The cement was allowed to set 72 hours before further work was performed. After 72 hours the casing and plug was tested with 1000 psi and did not show indications of leaking.
