DETAILS OF WORK

This well was completed 8-4-52 at TD 8075', FB 8070'. Pay is McKee and Connell 7656-8068'. Csg Pt. 7' at 8074'. Well is presently TDD.

To restore this well to production it is proposed to perforate the lower McKee formation from 7923-35', 7948-56', 7967-74', and 7982-96' w/4 jets per foot; treat and test Connell interval 8032-68' w/5,000 gallons standard sandfrac; treat and test new perforated intervals w/9,000 gallons standard sandfrac and treat present perforations w/21,000 gallons standard sandfrac in two separate stages.

Subsequent report, stating results obtained, will be submitted upon approval and completion of this work.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
