Gentlemen:

Please consider this the application of Shell Oil Company for a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be dedicated to Shell Livingston No. 9, Blinebry (Gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As seen on the attached plat, this well is located 2308 feet FWL and 1980 feet FSL of Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Livingston 9 was completed as a Blinebry (Gas) producer in October, 1953. Currently, 160 acres (outlined in red on the attached plat) are dedicated to this well. However, Shell Livingston No. 6, located within this 160-acre unit, was recently recompleted in the Blinebry (Oil) Field, resulting in this request of a 120-acre gas unit for Shell Livingston No. 9. The outline of the proposed 120-acre unit is shown in green on the attached plat.

Please advise if any other information is desired concerning this request.

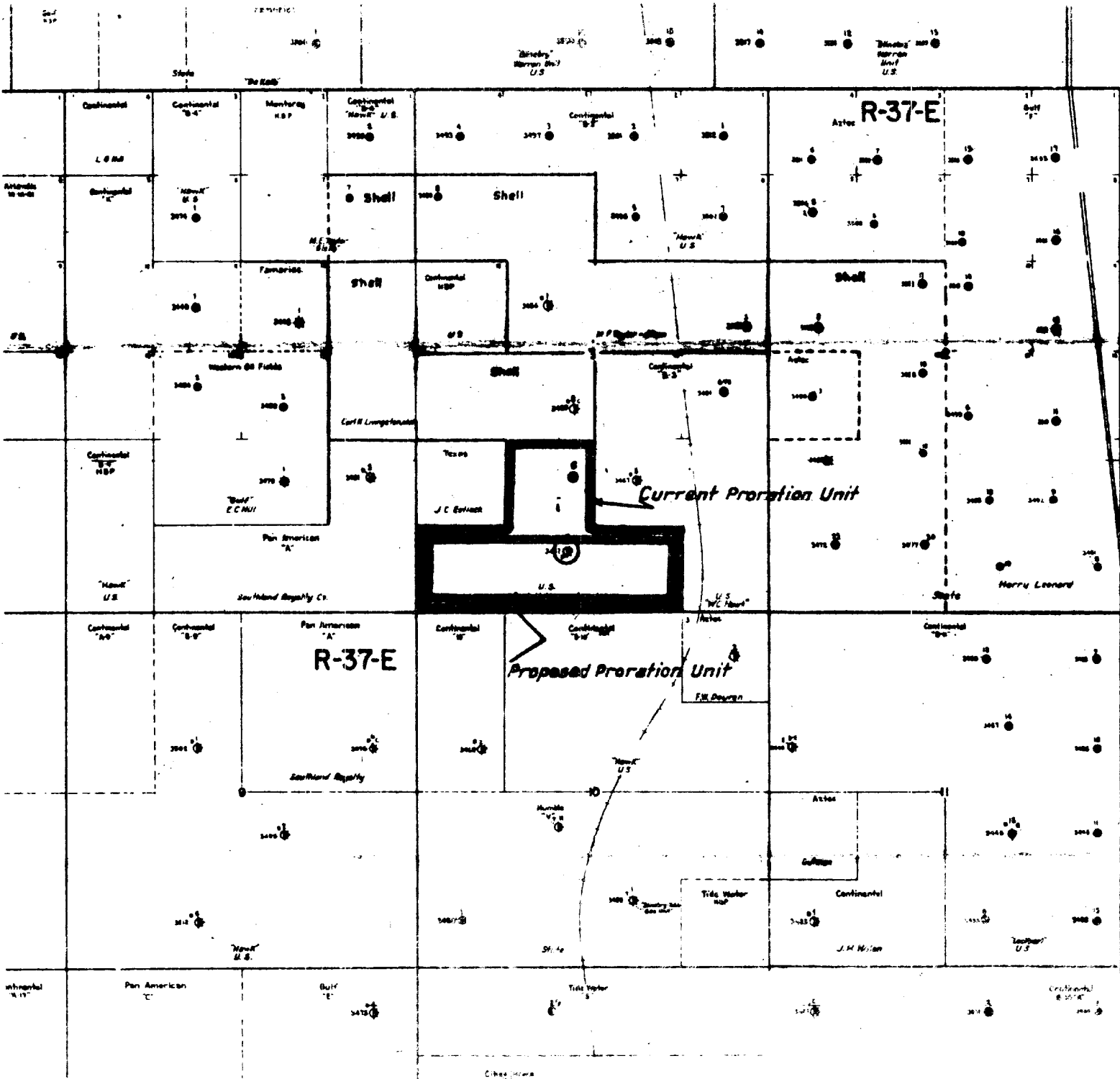
