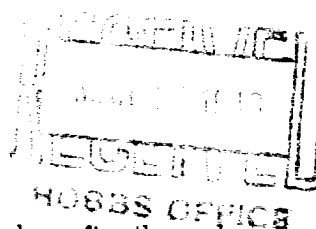

17-1/4" hole was carried 318', 13-3/8" O.D. casing was set at 295' and cemented with 325 sacks of cement. 400# pressure was applied Before and after drilling of plug and was allowed to stand for 30 minutes to check pressure decline. Held O.K.
