DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After waiting 48 hours tested 9 5/8" casing and plug with 1000# for 30 minutes - OK. Started drilling plug at 2777' at 3:30 a.m. 2-6-51. Completed drilling plug at 4:00 a.m. 2-6-51. Tested cement job with 1000# for 30 minutes - OK. After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.

Found top of cement behind 9 5/8" casing at 610' from surface.
