
Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Test Water Shut-Off" dated June 6, 1946, for your well No. 4-B Elliott, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, section 2, T. 28S., R. 37E., Brunson Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

The notice states that the cement will be allowed to set a minimum of 36 hours. Your attention is directed to the requirements attached to our approval letter dated May 29, 1946, and in particular to Item No. 10 requiring cement to set a minimum of 72 hours. Some exceptions may be allowed to the 72 hour minimum, but prior approval must be obtained from the district engineer. We suggest that you include proposed cement setting time in your Notice of Intention to Drill for all future operations, so that this office may approve any changes or modifications to the general conditions of approval in advance.

The approved notice is returned herewith, and we request your usual cooperation with our requirements in the future.
