

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Jet perforated 5 1/2-inch casing from 5070 to 5085 feet and 5090 to 5095 feet, with 3 holes per foot. 5 1/2-inch casing set at 5101 feet. Treated through perforations with 2000 gallons 15% acid in 2 stages. Sweet formation packer set at 5110 feet while acidizing. Packer hanging free now. On production test well flowed 126.67 barrels oil and 11.02 barrels water through 20/64-inch choke in 24 hours. FCP 500 p.s.i. FTP 225 p.s.i. G.O.R. 1618.
