## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 5147' Lime. Before acidizing well made 37-bbls oil in 50-minutes after using 500-gals of acid well flowed 16-bbls oil per hour on 12-hour test. After re-acidizing with 4000-gals of 15% non-emulsifying acid, well cleaned up to 1 1/2 BS & W in pits, then flowed 60-bbls of oil per hour on 3-hour test, through 5/8" Davidson choke, tubing pressure 500-lbs start of test, 550-lbs end of test. Casing pressure 100-lbs during test. Gravity 38.4 at 60-Deg. G.O.R. 990 to 1. Closed well in for lack of tank storage.
