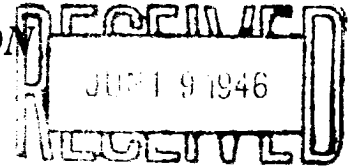

MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELLS

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

Total depth 2800' Anhydrite - After setting 8-5/8" O.D. 32# New Casing at 2798' and cementing with 3,000 sacks cement set for 48 hour, tested with 1200# for 30 minutes, drilled plug then retested with 1,000# for 30 minutes, test O. K. now drilling ahead.
