DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Prior to acid treatment, continuous flow had become impossible. Acidized the Ellenberger formation with 10,000 gallons of 15% acid after loaded hole with 363 bbls. of oil. Injection time 2 hrs, 40 minutes, duration of treatment 3 hrs Casing pressure 2500 to 2800#, Tubing pressure 1900 to 2650#. Well flowed only 1 hr and died. After recovery of load oil, 93 bbls. oil and 174 bbls. water was swabbed in 24 hours.
