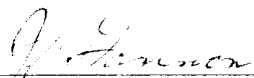

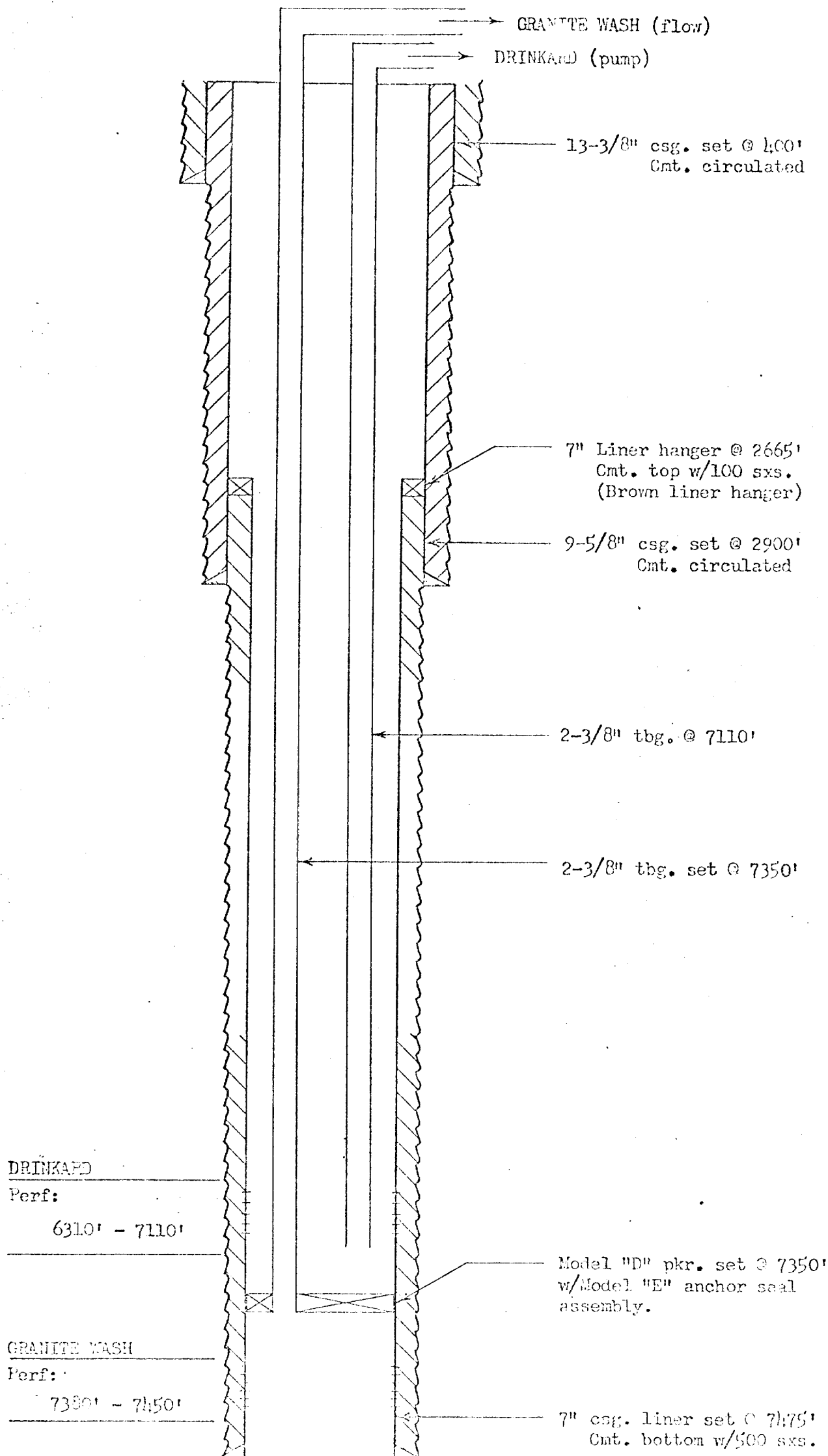

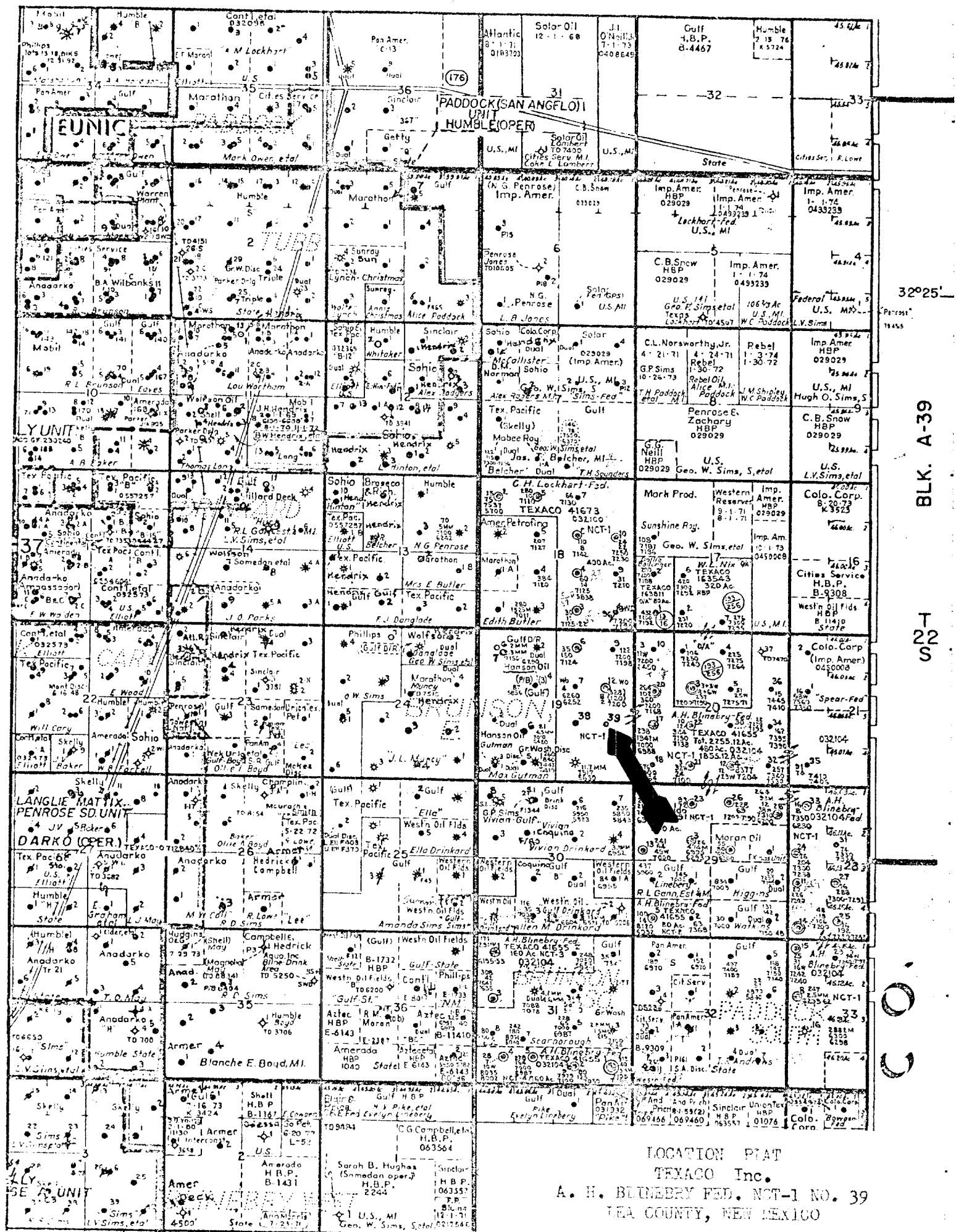
DIAGRAMATIC SKETCH
