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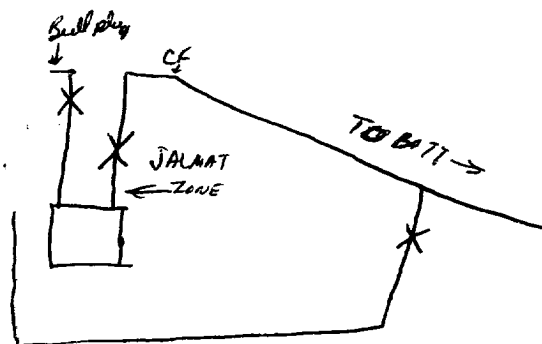

pursuant to the authority vested in me by Chapter 51, Laws of New Mexico 1959, the following rules relating to leasing of state oil and gas lands are hereby promulgated, to be effective to cover oil and gas produced from state lands on or after September 1, 1959:

Rule 52, pertaining to filing of production and royalty statements (Form SLO-111A), Rule 53, pertaining to filing of purchaser's run statements, and Rule 55, pertaining to filing of run tickets and tank tables, are repealed, and hereafter every oil and gas lessee of record (Meaning any holder of an original lease or an assignment of a portion thereof, which assignment has been approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands and which lessee is thereby responsible to the State of New Mexico for payment of royalty due from oil or gas production or to be credited to state lands) shall tender such royalty to the Commissioner of Public Lands through his agent
