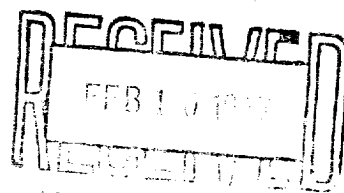

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged back from TD 3644 into 7" casing at 3466' and perforated 7" casing from 3456-3455 with 22 shots and 3425-3400 with 58 shots. Acidized through perforations with 1000 gallons. 15% acid. Gauged open flow of 2700 MCF per day through 2". Shut-in pressure was 575#.
