DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After 72 hrs. drill pipe was run in the hole, and 1000# pressure was put on casing before plug was drilled. There being no drop in pressure after standing 30 minutes plug was drilled and pressure again put on well. 1000# pressure was allowed to stay on well and there was no drop after 30 minutes. Gas was found to be completely shut off and drilling was resumed.

7" OD 24# Casing was set at 3485' and cemented w/300 sx.
