DETAILS OF WORK

July 2, 1950, at 5:30 P.M., 75 hours after being cemented, the 10-3/4" casing at 292' was tested for shut-off. Top of cement was found at 262' inside of pipe. Casing test made after bailing dry and allowing to stand 3 hours. No fluid entered. Cement plug drilled to 295' and bailed dry. Stood 3 hours for test and no fluid entered. Casing test and water shut-off test considered satisfactory. Drilled ahead with 10" bit.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
