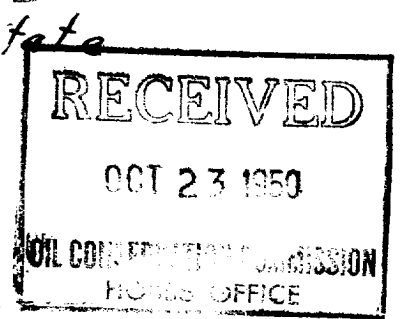



Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations, a copy of which has been furnished you and subject to the following conditions:

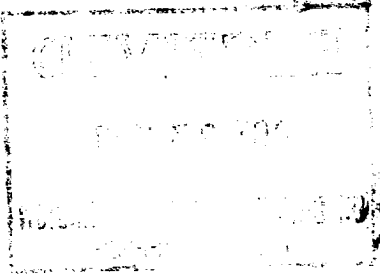
1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Copies of sample log, electrical log, temperature and other surveys made are requested.

Issuance of this approval letter has been delayed pending a study by this Department of your spacing program for wells in the South Leonard Pool. This approval should not be construed as establishing a general spacing pattern for oil wells in this pool and applies only to the 40 acre tract in which this well is located.
