

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudlogging jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

We propose to drill a well, using rotary tools, to approximately 6300' to explore for commercial production in the Drinkard formation. It is proposed to set 11 3/4" casing into the top of the anhydrite formation at approximately 850' cementing the casing to surface. It is proposed to set 7" casing to total depth of commercial production cementing same to base of salt at approximately 2150'. State and Federal regulations will be complied with.

The form was originally submitted on February 16, 1960.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
