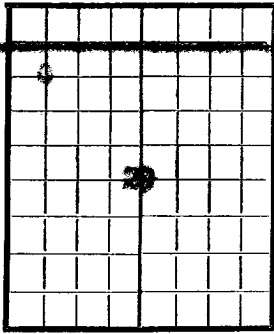


We have your letter of November 16, 1951, together with C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, which you have returned to us for revision for the reason that the cementing program does not meet with the requirements of the Oil Conservation Commission.

Our plans for completing this well involved lightly cementing the production string with fifty sacks of cement prior to drilling the pay. When and if a commercial well is developed, we plan to re-cement as shown in the attached C-101. This program was inadvertently omitted from our Notice of Intention to Drill. The Notice of Intention to Drill has been revised as above, and is resubmitted for your approval.
